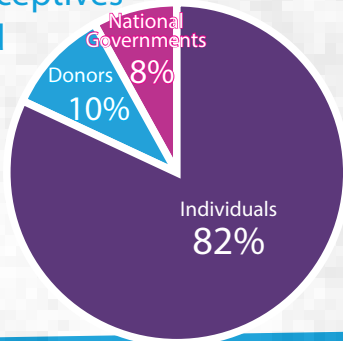
# THE WORLD IS FACING A CONTRACEPTIVE FUNDING CRISIS
