

Key Asks - Countdown 2030 Europe - Nairobi Summit Global Commitments

The Countdown 2030 Europe Consortium brings together 15 leading national and Brussels-based non-governmental organisations, drawing on a strong 10-year record of successful and strategic advocacy, we are working in 12 European countries and with the EU institutions to count down with European governments to 2030 and ensure that sexual and reproductive health and family planning are a funding priority for European donors and a policy priority in Europe and globally.

Nairobi Summit Global Commitments

Countdown welcomes the efforts of the government of the Republic of Kenya, the government of Denmark and the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) to convene a high-level conference to advance the implementation of the International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD) Programme of Action. And expects to see ambitious global and national commitments to ensure the accelerated implementation of the ICPD PoA.

Countdown suggestions for Global Commitments:

- We commit to ensure zero unmet need for family planning information and services and universal availability of quality, affordable and safe modern contraceptives by no later than 2030.
- We commit to ensure zero preventable maternal deaths by no later than 2030.
- We commit to integrate a comprehensive package of SRHR interventions¹ into national UHC strategies, policies and programmes.
- We commit to provide all young people with the information they need to decide freely and responsibly about their sexuality, to prevent unwanted pregnancies and to stay healthy.
- We commit to end all forms of sexual and gender based violence and discrimination against women and girls, by eliminating i.a. harmful practices such as child, early and forced marriage and female genital mutilation.
- We commit to ensure that the basic humanitarian needs of affected populations including sexual and reproductive health and rights are addressed as critical components of humanitarian response.
- We commit to intensify our efforts for the full, effective and accelerated implementation and funding of the ICPD Programme of Action and 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.
